# Funding opportunities

Your NPO is based in Austria:

## Co-funding opportunity by applying for a grant at FFG “Impact Innovation”

### How does it work?

1. Does this opportunity sound good to you? Give us a call and we can outline the next steps together.
2. You apply for our programme + apply for funding (“Impact Innovation” of FFG) in parallel à assistance from our side is possible.
3. Your application to the Inclusion Lab has been approved? Congratulations – you are now a part of the Exploration Phase.
4. *Your funding proposal was approved by FFG?* Perfect – your costs for the Inclusion Lab 2021 can be partly covered by FFG.
5. *Your funding proposal was not approved?* You can still join the Digital Development on your own budget.

## Opportunity for CEE Scholarship by ERSTE Foundation

### How does it work?

1. You apply for our programme + CEE Scholarship
2. Your application and scholarship was approved?  
Congratulations – you are a part of IL 2021!  
With the scholarship, your participation fee is reduced to EUR 0,- and your accommodation costs for workshops in persons are covered by the scholarship (your travel and staff costs are covered by yourself)
3. Your application was approved, but your scholarship was not: you can still join the Inclusion Lab 2021, however, you have to cover all costs yourself.

# Scope of the CEE scholarship

From our experience, we are aware that the investments we ask for are an extremely high investment for our partners from the CEE region and would potentially prevent you from participating. Nevertheless, we would love to collaborate with you. Therefore, **we have initiated the CEE Scholarship together with ERSTE Foundation**. Additional to the support granted to all participants of the Inclusion Lab, the **CEE Scholarship** includes the following benefits for its recipients:

- **Participation fee of EUR 8.500,-**
- **Accommodation costs for two NGO representatives** during all workshops in Vienna (decision on which workshops will take place in Vienna will be taken in 2021)

- The CEE Scholarship does not cover participants' travel costs.
- Accommodation will be organised by Two Next, reimbursements are not possible.

# Eligibility criteria for CEE Scholarship

## Organisations are eligible to apply, if:

- They have the legal status of a non-profit organisation.
- They are located in one of the following countries:  
ALB, BiH, CZ, HR, HU, MAC, MD, MNE, KOS, RO, SK, SLO, SRB
- They participate in all workshops and bootcamps of the Inclusion Lab 2021.

## Application:

- If you are interested in a CEE Scholarship, please check your eligibility with Two Next first and verify that you as organisation have a non-profit status.
- While [filling in the application form](#) for the Inclusion Lab 2021, you will be asked if you were in contact with Two Next and want to apply for a CEE Scholarship. Please tick 'yes' – and mention the name of the person who contacted Two Next.

**Your application to the Inclusion Lab 2021 and CEE Scholarship are linked. In case your organisation is selected to participate in the Lab, you will also receive the CEE Scholarship.**
